1. chance to start killing off the weeds and will need a further treatment for moss.

The a green will require a reasonable amount of continued treatment and care to ensure a good bowling surface for the upcoming season including needing to be cored at the commencement of the growing season of which we will be looking for as many volunteers as possible to help out with the work.
