It was an informative session and gave our sub committee some plausible and achievable goals. It also gave us a timeline and plan for the upcoming season. As of this weekend both greens have been treated for broadleaved weeds and moss. 2 further treatments at 14 day intervals will be required for our a green as well as a further treatment for winter grass. The b green will need to have the tops of the weeds removed once the herbicide has had a chance to start killing off the weeds and will need a further treatment for moss. The a green will require a reasonable amount of continued treatment and care to ensure a good bowling surface for the upcoming season including needing to be cored at the commencement of the growing season of which we will be looking for as many volunteers as possible to help out with the work.</p> <p>I would like to take this chance to thank all members of the sub committee for their involvement and hard work.
